- I. **DESCRIPTION**: Collins Correctional Facility is classified as a medium security correctional facility and is located in the Town of Collins in Erie County. Collins Correctional Facility is a general confinement facility used for males 18 years of age or older. Collins Correctional Facility has a Special Housing Unit (SHU) and a Residential Rehabilitation Unit (RRU). Collins Correctional Facility is also classified as a Work Release facility.
- II. FUNCTIONS: Collins Correctional Facility offers academic education, vocational training, volunteer services programs, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), transitional services, substance abuse treatment services, Integrated Dual Disorder Treatment/Residential Substance Abuse Treatment (IDDT/RSAT), Driving While Intoxicated Treatment Program (DWI), Sexual Offender Counseling and Treatment Program (SOCTP), family services, and community service work programs.

Collins Correctional Facility Work Release offers supportive services to assist incarcerated individuals with obtaining employment and housing in the communities that they will return to reside, prior to their release to Community Supervision.

Collins Correctional Facility is classified as Mental Health Service Level 2, as defined in Correction Law, Article I, Section 2(28).

- **III. CRITERIA**: To be eligible for placement in general confinement, an incarcerated individual must be designated medium security or less. To be eligible for placement in Work Release, the incarcerated individual must be approved for participation in a Temporary Release continuous program.
- **IV. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT**: Housing units at Collins Correctional Facility consist of dormitories, single and multiple occupancy rooms for general confinement of incarcerated individuals, and double cells for incarcerated individuals housed in SHU and RRU.
