

- I. DESCRIPTION:** Greene is classified as a medium security facility and is located in the Town of Coxsackie in Greene County. Greene is used for the general confinement of males 18 years of age or older.

Greene is also designated as an under 21 years of age facility, specifically to house incarcerated individuals that have been diagnosed with a learning or emotional disability.

Greene has a Special Housing Unit (SHU) and a Residential Rehabilitation Unit (RRU).

**II. FUNCTIONS**

A. Greene offers the following:

1. Academic education which includes:
  - a. Title 1
  - b. Special Education service
2. College programming
3. Vocational training
4. Volunteer services
5. Substance abuse treatment services
6. Transitional services which include aggression programs
7. Community Service Work programs that include:
  - a. Albany Training Academy
  - b. Office of General Services
  - c. Two crews for Community Service
  - d. Correctional Industries also supports customer inquiry services through a call center in connection with the NYS Department of Motor Vehicles.

B. Greene operates a Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS) Regional HUB Recycling Center that provides industrial training. This operation is capable of handling, processing, and marketing recyclables received from other DOCCS facilities as well as other agencies and municipalities within their region.

C. Greene requires all general confinement incarcerated individuals to participate in a structured housing unit program referred to as Community Lifestyles, which makes them accountable as a community and as individuals.

D. Greene is classified as Mental Health Services Level 3, as defined in Correction Law, Article 1, Section 2 (29).

- III. CRITERIA:** Incarcerated individuals must be designated medium security or less to be eligible for placement in general confinement at Greene.
- IV. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Greene consist of dormitories for general confinement, single cells for the SHU, and double cells for the RRU.
