- I. **DESCRIPTION:** Queensboro Correctional Facility is classified as a minimum security correctional facility and is located in Long Island City in Queens County. This facility is used for the general confinement of males 18 years of age or older and for returned parole violators (RPV) on technical violation status.
Queensboro Correctional Facility is also classified as a Work Release facility, and as a residential treatment facility, to temporarily house certain releasees in accordance with Subdivision 10 of Correction Law Section 73.
- II. **FUNCTIONS:** Queensboro Correctional Facility offers Re-entry Services. The principal objectives of the Re-entry Services Program are to provide incarcerated individuals having 120 days or less to serve with an opportunity to finalize their release plans, to work toward family and community reintegration, and to strive for an orderly transition back into society. In addition, incarcerated individuals in the program are prepared by representatives from both public and private sectors to make use of those resources upon release.
Queensboro Correctional Facility Work Release offers supportive services to assist incarcerated individuals with obtaining employment and housing in the communities that they will return to reside, prior to their release to Community Supervision.
Queensboro Correctional Facility is classified as Mental Health Service Level 4, as defined in Correction Law, Section 2 (30).
- III. **CRITERIA:** To be eligible for placement at Queensboro Work Release, the incarcerated individual must be approved for participation in a Temporary Release continuous program. To be eligible for the Queensboro Correctional Facility Re-entry Services Program, an incarcerated individual:
 - A. Must be minimum security.
 - B. Must have an approved parole release date within 120 days or a conditional release date within 120 days.
 - C. Must have release plans that call for residence in the lower Hudson Valley, NYC, and Long Island area.
 - D. Must not have an outstanding warrant or deportation order.
 - E. Must not have a conviction for a sex offense.
 - F. Must not be serving SHU time.
- IV. **PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Queensboro Correctional Facility consist of dormitories and restricted single cells.
