- I. **DESCRIPTION:** The Nassau Area Office is located in the Queens/Long Island Region and is physically located at 250 Fulton Avenue, Hempstead, NY. The Bureau is presently staffed with a Bureau Chief, Senior Parole Officers, and Parole Officers.
- II. **FUNCTIONS:** The Nassau Area Office is responsible for providing parole supervision, re-entry opportunities, and violation processing for releasees located in Nassau County, including all Nassau County Police Department Precincts (the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup>) and 17 incorporated village police departments.
- III. **SERVICES:** The Nassau Area Office supervises a releasee population that consists of Registered Sex Offenders, Discretionary Sex Offenders, Correctional Offender Management Profiling for Alternative Sanctions (COMPAS) Level 1-4 cases, and Mental Health cases.
- IV. **SPECIAL PROGRAMS:** The Nassau Area Office is a partner in Operation Gun Involved Violence Elimination (GIVE) in Nassau County and the Nassau County Re-Entry Task Force. The Nassau Area Office has no off-site report stations.
