- I. **DESCRIPTION**: The Albany Belt Area Office is located in the Hudson Valley Region and is physically located at 10 North Russell Road, Albany, NY. The Bureau is presently staffed with a Bureau Chief, Senior Parole Officers, and Parole Officers.
- **II. FUNCTIONS**: The Albany Belt Area Office is responsible for providing parole supervision, re-entry opportunities, and violation processing for releasees located in nine counties: Columbia, Fulton, Greene, Montgomery, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Schoharie, Warren, and Washington.
- III. SERVICES: The Albany Belt Area Office supervises a releasee population that consists of Registered Sex Offenders, Discretionary Sex Offenders, Correctional Offender Management Profiling for Alternative Sanctions (COMPAS) Level 1-4 cases, and Strict and Intensive Supervision and Treatment (SIST) cases.
- IV. SPECIAL PROGRAMS: The Albany Belt Area Office is a partner in Operation Gun Involved Violence Elimination (GIVE) in Rensselaer County, the Rensselaer County Re-Entry Task Force, and the Troy Albany Gang (TAG) Initiative. The Albany Belt Area Office has four off-site report stations.
