- I. DESCRIPTION: The Peekskill Sub-Area Office is located in the Hudson Valley Region and is physically located at 201 South James Street, Basement Level, Peekskill, NY. The Bureau is presently staffed with a Bureau Chief, Senior Parole Officers, and Parole Officers.
- **II. FUNCTIONS**: The Peekskill Sub-Area Office is responsible for providing parole supervision, re-entry opportunities, and violation processing for releasees located in Rockland and Putnam Counties.
- III. SERVICES: The Peekskill Sub-Area Office supervises a releasee population that consists of Registered Sex Offenders, Discretionary Sex Offenders, Correctional Offender Management Profiling for Alternative Sanctions (COMPAS) Level 1-4 cases, Mental Health cases, and Strict and Intensive Supervision and Treatment (SIST) cases.
- IV. SPECIAL PROGRAMS: The Peekskill Sub-Area Office is a partner in Operation Gun Involved Violence Elimination (GIVE) in Rockland County and the Rockland County Re-Entry Task Force. The Peekskill Sub-Area Office also supervises all releasees that are civilly committed to the Rockland County Psychiatric Center upon their release from a state correctional facility. The Peekskill Sub Area Office has one off-site report station.
