- I. **DESCRIPTION:** Hale Creek Correctional Facility is classified as a medium security correctional facility located in the Town of Johnstown in Fulton County. This secure facility is used for the confinement of males ages 18 and older.
Hale Creek Correctional facility also has a unit for certain parolees who are returned on a technical violation (45-day Parole Diversion Program).
- II. **FUNCTION:** Hale Creek Correctional Facility offers the Comprehensive Alcohol and Substance Abuse Treatment (CASAT) Program with Relapse Prevention, Alternative Shock Placement programs, academic education, counseling, vocational training, transitional services, Aggression Replacement Training (ART) and the Parole Diversion Program (PDP). Successful completion of the six-month CASAT Program can lead to work release or to a community-based residential program.
The Hale Creek PDP is designed to allow certain parolees, who have committed a technical violation of the term of their parole supervision, an opportunity to correct their problematic behavior before it escalates to the point of re-incarceration. The Hale Creek Correctional Facility's PDP can accommodate a maximum of 40 participants.
- III. **CRITERIA:** To be eligible for CASAT Program participation, an incarcerated individual must be presumptively approved for work release participation and be free of any physical or psychological conditions, which would preclude work release participation. Incarcerated individuals may be placed in CASAT by Court Order, provided they are medium security eligible, mentally and physically capable, and willing to participate in CASAT, with no expectations of subsequent work release participation if they did not receive presumptive approval for work release. However, they may continue to apply for work release or any other temporary release program.
Eligibility for the PDP requires the individual to be under Community Supervision and approved for participation after a technical parole violation.
- IV. **PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Hale Creek Correctional Facility consist of dormitories.
