I. DESCRIPTION: Albion Correctional Facility is classified as a medium security correctional facility and is located in the town of Albion in Orleans County. This facility is used for the general confinement of females 18 years of age or older.

Albion Correctional Facility is also classified as a work release facility. Albion Correctional Facility also houses Willard Drug Treatment Center (DTC) and Lakeview Shock Incarceration Correctional Facility (SICF) female parolees and incarcerated individuals in transit to and from these facilities, as well as violators with pending parole violation hearings.

Albion Correctional Facility serves as an Intake Center for females from upstate counties entering the Department pending transfer to Bedford Hills for complete reception/classification.

Albion Correctional Facility also has a special housing unit and a keeplock unit.

II. FUNCTION: Albion Correctional Facility offers academic education, vocational training, transitional services, industrial training programs, volunteer services programs, substance abuse treatment services, Sex Offender Counseling, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), special education for incarcerated individuals under 21 year of age with learning disabilities and college programs.

Albion Correctional Facility is classified a Mental Health Service Level 1, as defined in Correction Law, Section 2 (27) with a Residential Crisis Treatment Program (RCTP) consisting of observation cells and dormitory beds. DOCCS and Mental Health jointly operate an Intermediate Care Program (ICP), which offer Integrated Dual Disorder Treatment (IDDT) and a Group Therapy Program (GTP).

Albion Correctional Facility also offers Intermediate Care Program (ICP), a Female Trauma Recovery Program (FTRP), Family Reunion Program, Televisiting, and Pathstone (HIV testing and counseling).

III. CRITERIA: To be eligible for placement in general confinement, an incarcerated individual must be designated medium security or less.

To be eligible for placement at Albion Correctional Facility Work Release, the incarcerated individual must be approved for work/educational/community service release.

IV. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT: Housing at Albion Correctional Facility consists of single rooms, multiple occupancy rooms, and dormitories for incarcerated individuals in general confinement; and single cells in special housing and keeplock.
