- I. **DESCRIPTION:** Auburn Correctional Facility is classified as a maximum security correctional facility and is located in the city of Auburn in Cayuga County. This facility is used as a general confinement facility for males 21 years of age or older; however, males who are 18 years of age or older are eligible for placement in accordance with Title 7 NYCRR, Part 110.
Auburn Correctional Facility is also detention center for males 18 years of age or older.
Auburn Correctional Facility is an intake facility for males 18 years of age or older committed to the custody of the Department from the counties of Cayuga, Cortland, Herkimer, Jefferson, Madison, Onondaga, Ontario, Oswego, Seneca, and Wayne.
Auburn Correctional Facility has a special housing unit.
- II. **FUNCTIONS:** Auburn Correctional Facility offers academic education, vocational training, industrial training, volunteer services, counseling, transitional services, college programs, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), and substance abuse treatment services.
Auburn Correctional Facility is classified as Mental Health Service Level 1, as defined in Correction Law, Section 2 (27).
Auburn Correctional Facility offers a Transitional Intermediate Care Program (TRICP), an Intermediate Care Program (ICP) which includes a Seriously Mentally Ill-Violent component (SMIV), and a Residential Crisis Treatment Program (RCTP).
- III. **CRITERIA:** Incarcerated individuals of any security classification are eligible for placement at Auburn Correctional Facility.
- IV. **PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Auburn Correctional Facility consist of single cells and double cells. The special housing unit consists of single cells. The RCTP unit consists of observation cells and a dormitory.
