1		NY is an "open book" state ,and as such, awarded contracts, their total value and the awarded party are available to the public. Are the specifics of the awarded contract available to the public as well? Information such as number of years, number of sites included in the contract, monetary value of each site etc?	Contracts are disclosable through FOIL unless the records or portions thereof are exempt from disclosure.
2	Page 24 section 3 – Repairs/ emergency services	The notes indicate that the contract includes parts. Since this note is under the emergency services section, we assume that the parts that are being replaced (provided that the site doesn't have them in stock) will be billed under emergency services. Is that correct? if so – the price per day in the emergency service section should also include the cost of estimated number of parts that we will need replacement. If not – would parts be billed completely separately from this contract?	If parts are provided whether it be during an annual maintenance or emergency repair, they should be billed as separate line items with that service but should be covered under the contract.
3		Are the names of other bidder on this project available? Can you share this information?	This question is not relevant to the development of a proposal under this IFB.
