ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES CALENDAR YEAR 2022

DOCCS POPULATION: The population in the Department of Corrections and Community Supervision facilities (including incarcerated releasees) and under the Department’s jurisdiction increased by 739 incarcerated individuals (+2.4%) from the end of December 2021 to the end of December 2022. The number of individuals in state ready status stood at 267 at the close of December 2022, compared to 443 at the close of December 2021, down 176 (-39.7%). Overall, bedspace demand increased by 1.8% (+563).

ADMISSIONS: Total admissions for CY 2022 at 10,264 were 1,129 above (+12.4%) the 9,135 recorded during this period in 2021. Court commitments increased by 2,720 (+43.3%). Admissions for violating parole conditions decreased by 1,326 (-56.9%). There were 16 participants admitted to an Alternative treatment program in 2022, down 244 (-93.8%) from 2021. Other admissions decreased by 21 (-8.2%).

*Individuals returned to custody for violating conditions of parole supervision; prior to March 2022, this includes warrants issued for a new arrest, absconding or a technical violation. Starting on March 1, 2022, this includes non-technical violations, absconding or technical violations where reincarceration is possible.

INCARCERATED RELEASEE ADMISSIONS: Total incarcerated releasee admissions for CY 2022 at 427 were 19.7% lower than the 532 recorded for CY 2021 (-105 admissions). Drug Treatment JS admissions decreased by 72 (-18.3%) from 2021. Drug Treatment Parole Violator admissions increased by 1 (+33.3%). There were 102 participants admitted to Other Programs during 2022, a decrease of 34 (-25.0%) from 2021.

RELEASES: There were 9,602 incarcerated individuals released from DOCCS facilities during CY 2022 which was 3,146 less (-24.7%) than the 12,748 released during 2021. Releases to Community Supervision decreased by 23.8%, down 2,696 from 11,341 in 2021 to 8,645 in 2022. Parole releases accounted for 3,218 of the CY 2022 releases compared to 4,815 in 2021, down 1,597 (-33.2%). Conditional releases at 4,616 were 13.0% below the 5,308 in 2021 (-692 conditional releases). There were 40 cases released following participation in the Alternative treatment program, down 291 (-87.9%) from 2021. Releases at maximum expiration of sentence decreased by 419 (-51.5%).

INCARCERATED RELEASEE RELEASES: There were 504 incarcerated releasees released from DOCCS facilities during CY 2022, which was 78 less (-13.4%) than the 582 released in 2021. Drug Treatment JS releases accounted for 361 of the CY 2022 releases compared to 332 in 2021, up 29 (+8.7%). Drug Treatment PV releases at 6 was 55 less than the 61 in 2021 (-90.2%). There were 137 participants released from Other Programs during 2022, a decrease of 52 (-27.5%) from 2021.
