IFB #2023-08 – Badges

The following are official modifications which are hereby incorporated into IFB 2023-08 – Badges. The information contained in this addendum prevails over the original IFB language. For all amendments below, deleted language appears in strikethrough (“~~xxx~~”) and added language appears in bold underline (“**xxx**”).

IFB #2023-08, DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS, as listed on pages 20, 23, 25 27, have been updated to change required samples to DOCCS as follows:

Page 20: CONSTRUCTION:

Badge shall be manufactured from 10 to 14 gauge gilding metal, hot nickel-plated. Finished material shall be 24K gold plated.

The gold plate content of the badge, excluding the clasp, shall be a minimum of .008 grams. Center of badge (state seal and ‘State of New York’) shall have a diameter of 15/16” and background shall be filled in with ~~jeweler’s hard fired enamel~~. **Inlaid Epoxy Resin Enamel**, royal blue in color.

Lettering, numbers and titles shall be 1/8” high and filled in with flush type enamel, royal blue in color.

A wallet clip approximately 1/4” wide, length appropriate to badge, shall be affixed to the back of the badge if requested.

Page 23: CONSTRUCTION:

Badge shall be manufactured from 10 to 14 gauge gilding metal, hot nickel-plated. Finished material shall be 24K gold plated.

The gold plate content of the badge, excluding the clasp, shall be a minimum of .008 grams.

Center of badge (state seal and ‘State of New York’) shall have a diameter of 15/16” and background shall be filled in with ~~jeweler’s hard fired enamel~~. **Inlaid Epoxy Resin Enamel**, royal blue in color.

Lettering and titles shall be 1/8” high and filled in with flush type enamel, royal blue in color.

Drop Down numbers shall be approximately 7/16” high.

A wallet clip approximately 1/4” wide, length appropriate to badge, shall be affixed to the back of the badge if requested.

Page 25: CONSTRUCTION:

Badge shall be manufactured from 10 - 14 gauge gilding metal, hot nickel-plated. Finished material shall be 24K gold plated.

The gold plate content of the badge, excluding the clasp, shall be a minimum of .008 grams.

NOTE: yellow and white metals as shown in illustration.

Center of badge (state seal and 'State of New York') shall have a diameter of 15/16" and shall be filled in with ~~jeweler's hard fired enamel~~ **Inlaid Epoxy Resin Enamel**, various colors as shown in illustration.

Lettering, numbers and titles shall be 1/8" high and filled in with flush type enamel, royal blue in color. A wallet clip approximately 1/4" wide, length appropriate to badge, shall be affixed to the back of the badge if requested.

Page 27: SAMPLES

The bidder MUST submit a sample of the type of badge(s) being bid prior to the opening of bids. The sample(s) shall be labeled on the exterior of the package with the Invitation for Bid Number, Bid Opening date and the Item No. ~~The sample(s) shall be of the same material, quality, style, construction, workmanship, and finish as offered in the bid and conform to the required specifications.~~ **DOCCS will accept samples of badges demonstrating a representation of the required specifications.** The sample shall be supplied at the bidder's expense. Any descriptive literature relating to badge construction should also be included. A detailed description of the bidder's manufacturing method must be submitted with sample(s). The successful bidder's sample shall be retained until the expiration of the contract or at the discretion of the State.

~~Conformance with~~ **Bid** Sample(s) **provided with Bid**: Submission of a sample and approval thereof shall not relieve the Contractor from full compliance with all terms and conditions, performance related and otherwise, specified in the Bid Specifications. If in the judgment of DOCCS the sample or product submitted is not in accordance with the specifications or testing requirements prescribed in the Bid Specifications, DOCCS may reject the Bid. If after award the contractor fails to meet conformance of all detailed specifications, DOCCS may cancel the Contract at the expense of the Contractor. DOCCS reserves the right to request additional samples at no cost to the State as required for evaluation.

DOCCS may require the tentative awardee to have the sample tested for metal properties as specified in the bid specifications. The expense for such testing will be the responsibility of the tentative awardee.

After award pre-production graphics and samples shall be submitted as instructed. Production shall not begin until DOCCS has approved pre-production sample(s).

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
