I. DESCRIPTION: Albion Correctional Facility is classified as a medium security correctional facility and is located in the town of Albion in Orleans County. This facility is used for the general confinement of females 18 years of age or older.

Albion Correctional Facility is also classified as a work release facility.

Albion Correctional Facility serves as an Intake Center for females from upstate New York counties entering the Department pending transfer to Bedford Hills Correctional Facility for complete reception/classification.

Albion Correctional Facility also has a Special Housing Unit (SHU) and a Residential Rehabilitation Unit (RRU).

II. FUNCTION: Albion Correctional Facility offers academic education, vocational training, transitional services, industrial training programs, volunteer services programs, substance abuse treatment services, Sex Offender Counseling, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), special education for incarcerated individuals 21 years of age and under with learning disabilities, and college programs.

Albion Correctional Facility is classified a Mental Health Service Level 1, as defined in Correction Law, Article I, Section 2 (27) with a Residential Crisis Treatment Program (RCTP) consisting of observation cells and dormitory beds. The Department of Corrections and Community Supervision and Office of Mental Health jointly operate an Intermediate Care Program (ICP), which offers Integrated Dual Disorder Treatment (IDDT) and a Group Therapy Program (GTP).

Albion Correctional Facility also offers a Female Trauma Recovery Program (FTRP), Family Reunion Program, Televisiting, and Pathstone (HIV testing and counseling).

III. CRITERIA: To be eligible for placement in general confinement, an incarcerated individual must be designated medium security or less.

To be eligible for placement at Albion Correctional Facility Work Release, the incarcerated individual must be approved for work/educational/community service release.

IV. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT: Housing at Albion Correctional Facility consists of single rooms, multiple occupancy rooms, and dormitories for incarcerated individuals in general confinement; and single cells in SHU and RRU.
