- I. **DESCRIPTION:** Eastern New York is classified as a maximum security correctional facility and is located in the Hamlet of Napanoch in Ulster County. This facility is used for the general confinement of males 18 years of age and older.
Eastern New York has a special housing unit.
- II. **FUNCTIONS:** Eastern New York offers counseling services, academic education, vocational training, industrial training programs, college programs, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), substance abuse programming, transitional services, and volunteer services programs.
Eastern New York also operates the Sensorially Disabled Unit to meet the special needs of visually and hearing impaired incarcerated individuals.
Eastern New York is classified as Mental Health Service Level 2, as defined in Correction Law, Section 2 (28).
- III. **CRITERIA:** Incarcerated individuals of security classification maximum A or lower are eligible for placement at Eastern New York and must have previously demonstrated a positive response to authority and an ability to function in a less restrictive environment than that found at a large maximum security facility.
- IV. **PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Eastern New York consist of single cells and dormitories. The special housing unit consists of single cells.
