I. DESCRIPTION: Orleans Correctional Facility is classified as a medium security facility and is located in the town of Albion in Orleans County. The facility is used for the general confinement of males 18 years of age or older. Orleans Correctional Facility is also classified as a Work Release facility operating a Work Release and a Community Services Leave Program.

Orleans Correctional Facility has one Special Housing Unit (SHU) and a Residential Rehabilitation Unit (RRU) for those serving disciplinary confinement sanctions.

II. FUNCTIONS: Orleans Correctional Facility offers academic education, vocational training, transitional services, volunteer service programs, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), substance abuse treatment services, the Temporary Release Programs, and the Canine Training Program.

Orleans Correctional Facility's Temporary Release programs (Work Release and Community Services Leave) offer supportive services to assist incarcerated individuals to obtain employment, housing, and available resources in the communities that they will return to reside upon their release to Community Supervision.

III. CRITERIA: To be eligible for placement in general confinement, an incarcerated individual must be designated medium security or less.

To be eligible for placement at Orleans Correctional Facility for Work Release or Community Services Leave, the incarcerated individual must be approved for participation in a Temporary Release continuous program by Central Office Temporary Release.

IV. PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT: Housing units at Orleans Correctional Facility consist of dormitories. The SHU consists of single cells. The RRU consists of double cells.
