- I. **DESCRIPTION**: The Albany Area Office is located in the Hudson Valley Region and is physically located at 10 North Russell Road, Albany, NY. The Bureau is presently staffed with a Bureau Chief, Senior Parole Officers, and Parole Officers.
- **II. FUNCTIONS**: The Albany Area Office is responsible for providing parole supervision, reentry opportunities, and violation processing for releasees located in Albany and Schenectady Counties.
- III. SERVICES: The Albany Area Office supervises a releasee population that consists of Registered Sex Offenders, Discretionary Sex Offenders, Correctional Offender Management Profiling for Alternative Sanctions (COMPAS) Level 1-4 cases, Mental Health cases, and Strict and Intensive Supervision and Treatment (SIST) cases.
- IV. SPECIAL PROGRAMS: The Albany Area Office is a partner in the Operation Gun Involved Violence Elimination (GIVE) Initiative in the cities of Albany and Schenectady, and the Albany and Schenectady County Re-Entry Task Forces. The Albany Area Office has one off-site report station.
