



**NYS Board of Parole
Business Meeting
July 28, 2025**

Chairman Darryl C. Towns called the **July 28, 2025**, Board of Parole Regular Business Meeting to order at 11:04 AM. The meeting was conducted in-person at the DOCCS Training Academy in Albany, New York.

Old Business

Chairman Towns, Commissioner Crangle and Executive Deputy Director Vizvary attended the Association of Paroling Authorities International Conference in Atlanta, GA. Next year's conference is scheduled to be in New Orleans and the Board hopes to send a group again.

The Board attended a roundtable discussion presented by the Fortune Society. Several re-entry groups as well as justice involved individuals were in attendance and shared their stories and experiences.

The Board has been working with the National Institute of Corrections to implement a structured decision-making framework. The Board has completed the assessment phase and is moving to the implementation and training phases of the project.

New Business

The Board voted to have regulations concerning minor offenders posted to the State Register for the 60-day public comment period. Motion made by Commissioner Crangle, seconded by Commissioner Enright and carried to post the regulations.

The Board had 4 new members confirmed in June 2025: Commissioners José Gómez, Daniel O'Donnell, Darlene Grant Bruce and Elizabeth Kase.
