Annual Mortality Report

2024

Introduction

This report presents information about the deaths of individuals under DOCCS' custody, regardless of where the death occurred; thus, hospital deaths are included. Any death of an escapee or an absconder is excluded since they were not under DOCCS' custody at the time of death. Any death of a detainee (individuals from other jurisdictions who are being held temporarily in DOCCS' facilities) is included. The deaths reported for 2024 do not include any detainees; the last detainee deaths occurred in 2022 (1) and 2021 (1).

The manner of death presented corresponds to the manner of death recorded on the Department's unusual incident system. The manner of death categories include accident, homicide, natural, overdose, suicide and unknown. This system is updated based on information received from autopsy reports. However, this system does not record information regarding the cause of death. Pursuant to NYS County Law §671 and §674, the official cause of death for all incarcerated individual deaths is determined by the county coroner or medical examiner. County Law §677 leaves it to the county coroner and medical examiner to determine if results will be released and to whom. Therefore, the manner of death is presented in this report, not cause of death.

For historical context, Table 9 presents information about manner of death for deaths between 2020 and 2024. In addition to manner of death, this report also presents demographic and legal characteristics of the individuals whose deaths are reported.

This data is preliminary and is based on data on file as of November 3, 2025. At the time of this report, not all autopsy results had been received. Therefore, although the number of deaths reported will not change, the manner of death reported may change based on the manner of death reported in official autopsy results. Updated manners of death will be reflected in the trend table in next year's report.

All rates presented are per 10,000 incarcerated individuals. Between 2020 and 2024, the mortality rate for deaths at DOCCS was 37.2 per 10,000 or 372.3 per 100,000. The mortality rate increased in 2024 following a decline in 2022 and 2023. The 2024 rate of 43.38 was slightly higher than the last high point in 2021 (42.86 per 10,000 incarcerated individuals).

Based on the most recent national figures for deaths in state prisons between 2001 and 2019, New York's mortality rate was about the same as or lower than other large states. Between 2001 and 2019, the mortality rate for deaths in New York state prisons was 250 per 100,000. This was comparable to California and Ohio (247 per 100,000) and lower than Pennsylvania (331 per 100,000), Florida (319 per 100,000) and Texas (274 per 100,000)(see <https://bjs.ojp.gov/library/publications/mortality-state-and-federal-prisons-2001-2019-statistical-tables>).

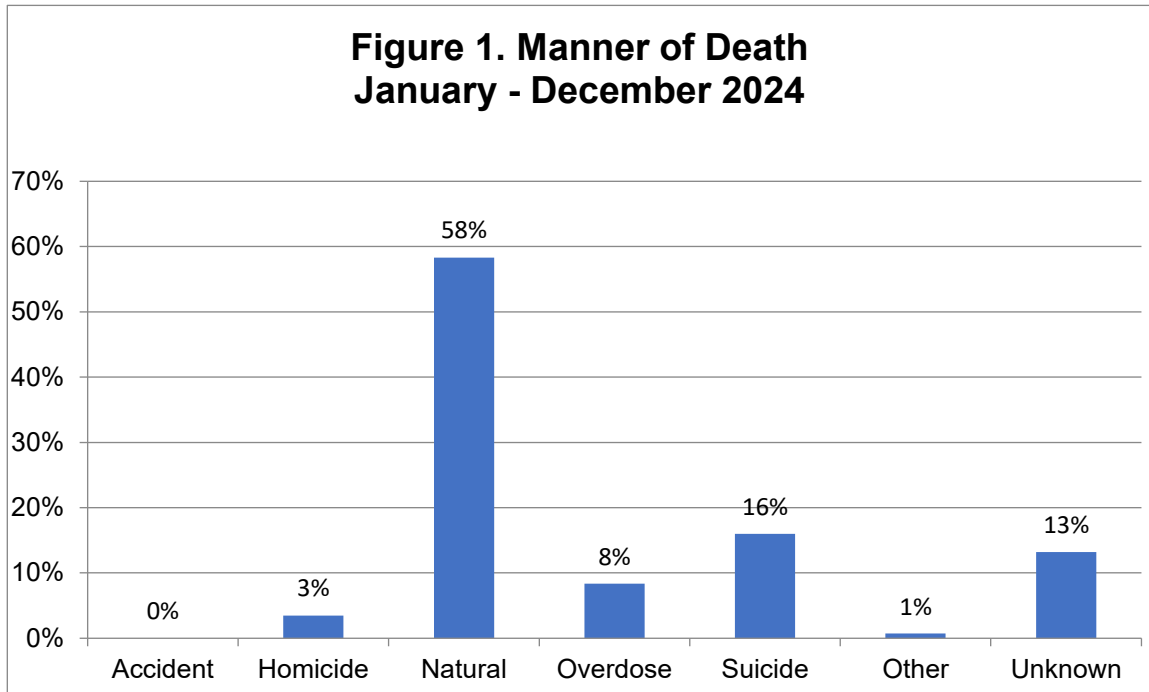

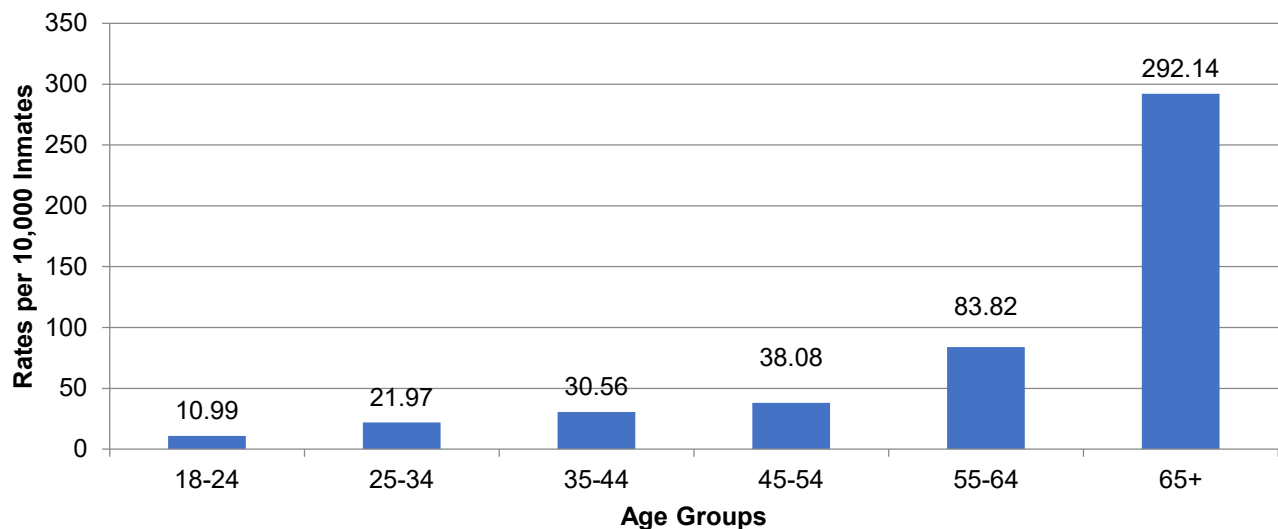

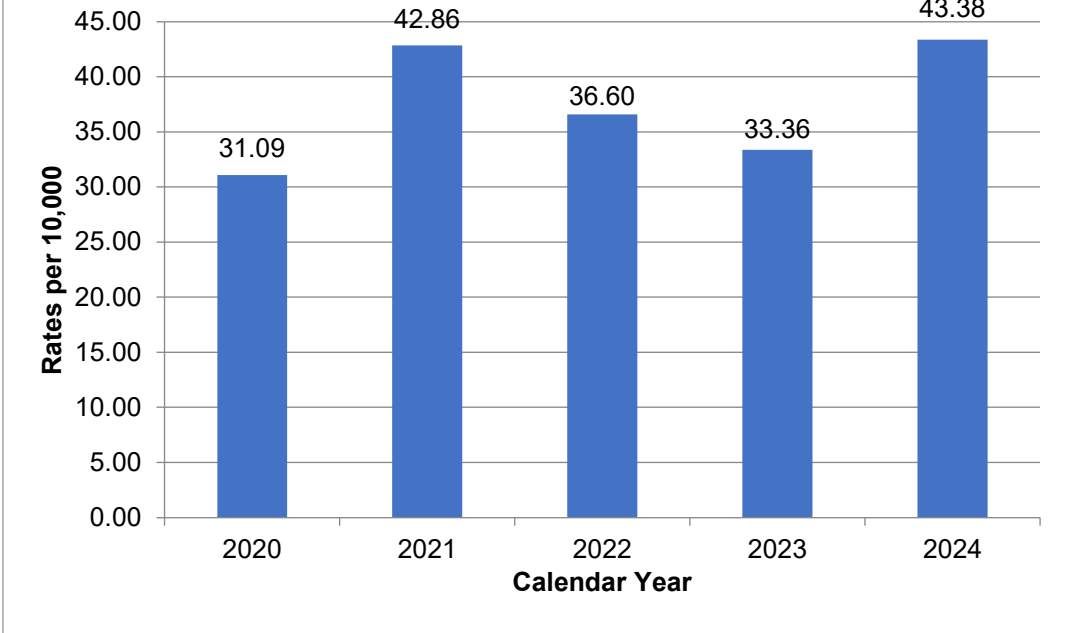
