4.0 Scope of Work

4.1 Program Overview

The program will operate in a cohort type system, with one (1) cohort at each of the four (4) facilities per year. Each contract year will include training for a complete cohort. There will be a total of 20 students per facility, for a total 80 students per year. The anticipated total of program graduates from all four (4) program sites across two (2) years will be 160 individuals. Classes will run five (5) days a week (Monday through Friday), 50 weeks a year with no classes on federal/state holidays or during lockdowns. Each class will consist of two (2), 3-hour modules per day with a total of 8 hours per day. Classes are anticipated to begin three months after the contract start date.

5.11 Payment

~~DOCCS will retain 20% of the cost of course instruction ("Retainage") for the two (2) cohorts (10% for each cohort). Prior to DOCCS releasing any Retainage, the course for each cohort must be successfully completed, all reporting received by DOCCS, and certifications presented to students. Each completed cohort shall have been accepted and DOCCS shall have indicated all course instruction has been completed to DOCCS' satisfaction, such satisfaction not to be unreasonably withheld.~~

~~Each option, if exercised, will include a 10% retainage each that will follow the same procedures as noted in the paragraph above.~~
